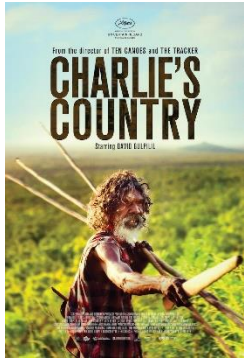
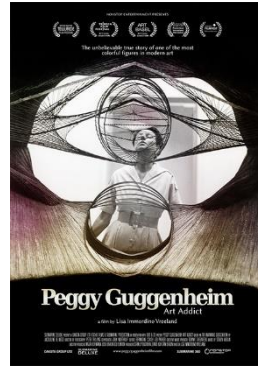


NOVEMBER 3rd, 2017

WSU East Auditorium

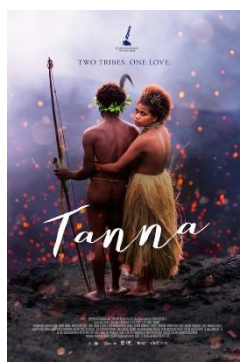
Based on the sole authorized biography, this film examines how Guggenheim transformed a modest fortune into a premiere collection of 20<sup>th</sup> century art through her impeccable taste, financial savvy and tendency to collect not just art, but artists themselves.

**Charlie's Country** (2013)  
Drama. Australia. Yolngu Matha/  
English. NR. 108 min.  
WSU East Auditorium

Charlie, an Aborigine in Arnhem Land, feels increasingly out of place in modern Australia with less and less room for his cultural practices and beliefs. After a confrontation with police over his traditional spear, he leaves his urban Aboriginal community to return to the bush in search of his "Mother Country".

**Tanna** (2015)  
Drama/Romance. Australia, Vanuatu.  
Nauvhal. NR. 104 min.

An unusual production, this true to life Romeo and Juliet story was cast with the people from the Yakel tribe on the South Pacific Vanuatu island. Covered in rain forest and dominated by an active volcano, this heartfelt story tells of a sister's loyalty, a forbidden love affair and the pact between the old ways and the new.

OCTOBER 6, 2017

**The Secret in Their Eyes** (2009)  
Drama/Mystery/Romance. Argentina.  
Spanish. R. 129 min.  
WSU East Auditorium

A retired legal counselor writes a novel hoping to find closure for one of his past unresolved homicide cases and for his unreciprocated love with his superior - both of which still haunt him decades later. Winner of the 2010 Academy Award for Best Foreign Language Film and the Goya Award for Best Spanish Language Foreign Film.



DECEMBER 1, 2017

**The Salesman** (2016)  
Drama/Thriller. Iran. Persian. PG-13.  
124 min.

While a teacher and his wife are participating in a production of "Death of a Salesman," the wife is assaulted in their new, home, leaving her husband determined to find the perpetrator, over her traumatized objections. Parallel themes between the film and the play are intrinsically emphasized.

**Kahaani** (2012)  
Drama/Mystery/Thriller. India. Hindi.  
NR. 122 min.  
WSU East Auditorium

A pregnant woman's search for her missing husband takes her from London to Kolkata, but everyone she questions denies having ever met him. Made with a shoe-string budget, this film was hugely successful and influential and is winner of 3 National Film Awards, the most prominent film award in India.



DECEMBER 15, 2017

**Belle & Sebastian** (2013)  
Adventure/Family. France.  
French/German. NR. 104 min.

Taking place in 1943 in a Nazi-invaded small village in the French Alps, a six-year-old orphan boy and a stray dog become embroiled in an adventure where each will depend on the other to save their own, and others, lives. A heartwarming and emotional film perfect for the holiday season.
